Emilie Beard Foundation for Felines (dba EB Feline Rehoming) is dedicated to rescuing, providing sanctuary, insuring good health, and placing cats and kittens into loving and pet-responsible homes. We strive to educate the public about the importance of neuter and spay to help reduce the population of unwanted, homeless, or abandoned cats in our community.

Because we do not have a physical shelter, we always need foster homes for our cats and kittens who are awaiting adoption. The kittens need a safe place separate from other animals initially. We can provide cages, but kittens still need a place to play and interact socially, especially as they get bigger. Living in the nurturing environment of a foster home makes our kittens healthier and happier and better prepared for their new forever homes.

As a foster cat-parent, you provide love, socialization (playing with the cats, holding them, petting them) and physical care (feeding, watering, cleaning litter boxes once or twice daily, as well as observing the cats or kittens for any health concerns and reporting those to us immediately). Your care can make a huge difference in helping the cats get adopted and can help us save even more cats and kittens.

Although we can provide food, food dishes, beds, litter boxes and litter, we would be more than happy to have you furnish those, which are tax-deductible. Of course we are happy to try to answer any questions that come up when you're fostering. We also provide veterinary care, and any needed medications. Donations toward our veterinary expenses are always welcome, and much needed.
